# *Courses offered and eligibility criteria*

## **B.A. (H) English**

- We have 62 seats offered for this course out of which **31** are reserved for minority
- Course fee: Rs 17885
- Eligibility Criteria
  - Candidates must appear in CUET in the following subject combination:  
English from List A + Any two subjects from List B1 + Any one subject from either List B1 or List B2
  - Merit will be based on the CUET scores obtained from the above-mentioned combination of subjects.

## **B.A. (H) Hindi**

- We have 123 seats offered for this course out of which **62** are for minority
- Course fee: Rs 17685
- Eligibility Criteria
  - Candidates must appear in CUET in the following subject combination:  
Hindi from List A+ Any two subjects from List B1 + Any one subject from either List B1 or List B2
  - Merit will be based on the CUET scores obtained from the above-mentioned combination of subjects.

# *Courses offered and eligibility criteria*

## **B.A. (Hons.) Punjabi**

- We offer total 46 seats offered for this course out of which 23 are for minority
- Course fee: Rs 6035
- Eligibility Criteria
  - Candidates must appear in CUET in the following subject combination:  
Combination I: Punjabi from List A + Any two subjects from List B1 + Any one subject from List B1 or List B2  
OR  
Combination II: Any one language from List A + Any two subjects from List B1 + Any one subject either from List B1 or List B2
  - Merit will be based on the CUET scores obtained from the above-mentioned combination of subjects.
  - Candidates who opted for Combination II for admission will be considered only if seats remain vacant after considering all the candidates who opted for Combination I

# *Courses offered and eligibility criteria*

## **B.A. (H) Sanskrit**

- We offer 31 seats offered for this course out of which **16** are reserved for minority

- Course fee: Rs 6035

- Eligibility Criteria

➤ Candidates must appear in CUET in the following subject combination:

Combination I: Any one Language from List A + Sanskrit from List B1 + Any two subjects out of which one should be from List B1

OR

Combination II: Any one Language from List A + Sanskrit from List A + Any two subjects out of which one should be from List B1

OR

Combination III: Sanskrit from List A + Any three subjects out of which at least two should be from List B1

OR

Combination IV: Any one Language from List A + Any two subjects from List B1 + Any one subject from either List B1 or List B2

- Merit will be based on the CUET scores obtained from the above-mentioned combination of subjects.
- Candidates who opted for Combination IV for admission will be considered only if seats remain vacant after considering all the candidates who opted for Combination I/II/III

## **B.A. (H) Psychology**

- We have 62 seats offered for this course out of which **31** are reserved for minority
- Course fee: Rs 20085
- Eligibility Criteria
  - Candidates must appear in CUET in the following subject combination:  
Any one Language from List A + Any two subjects from List B1 + Any one subject from either List B1 or List B2
  - Merit will be based on the CUET scores obtained from the above-mentioned combination of subjects.

## **B.A. (Hons.) Philosophy**

- We have 46 seats offered for this course out of which **23** are reserved for minority
- Course fee: Rs 17685
- Eligibility Criteria
  - Candidates must appear in CUET in the following subject combination:  
Any one Language from List A + Any two subjects from List B1 + Any one subject from either List B1 or List B2
  - Merit will be based on the CUET scores obtained from the above-mentioned combination of subjects.

## **B.A. (Hons.) History**

- We have 62 seats offered for this course out of which **31** are reserved for minority
- Course fee: Rs 17685

- Eligibility Criteria
  - Candidates must appear in CUET in the following subject combination:  
Any one Language from List A + Any two subjects from List B1 + Any one subject from either List B1 or List B2
  - Merit will be based on the CUET scores obtained from the above-mentioned combination of subjects.

## **B.Sc. (Hons.) Mathematics**

- We have 62 seats offered for this course out of which **31** are reserved for minority
- Course fee: Rs 19475
- Eligibility Criteria
  - Candidates must appear in CUET in the following subject combination:  
Any one language from List A + Mathematics + Any two subjects out of which one should be from List B1
  - Merit will be based on the CUET scores obtained from the above-mentioned combination of subjects.

## **B.Sc. (Hons.) Computer Science**

- We have 46 seats offered for this course out of which **23** are reserved for minority
- Course fee: Rs 24700
- Eligibility Criteria
  - Candidates must appear in CUET in the following subject combination:  
Any one language from List A + Mathematics + Any two subjects out of which one should be from List B1
  - Merit will be based on the CUET scores obtained from the above-mentioned combination of subjects.

# *Courses offered and eligibility criteria*

## **B.Sc. (Hons.) Statistics**

- We have 46 seats offered for this course out of which **23** are reserved for minority
- Course fee: Rs 20235
- Eligibility Criteria
  - Candidates must appear in CUET in the following subject combination:  
Any one language from List A + Mathematics + Any two subjects out of which one should be from List B1
  - Merit will be based on the CUET scores obtained from the above-mentioned combination of subjects.

# *Courses offered and eligibility criteria*

## **B.Com. (Hons.)**

- We have 123 seats offered for this course out of which **62** are reserved for minority
- Course fee: Rs 19085
- Eligibility Criteria
  - Candidates must appear in CUET in the following subject combination:  
Combination I: Any one Language from List A + Mathematics + Any two subjects out of which at least one should be from List B1
  - OR
  - Combination II: Any one Language from List A + Accountancy + Any two subjects out of which at least one should be from List B1
  - Merit will be based on the CUET scores obtained from the above-mentioned combination of subjects.

# *Courses offered and eligibility criteria*

## **B.Com**

- We have 185 seats offered for this course out of which 93 are reserved for minority
- Course fee: Rs 18885
- Eligibility Criteria
  - Candidates must appear in CUET in the following subject combination:  
Combination I: Any one Language from List A + Any two subjects from List B1 + Any one subject from either List B1 or List B2
  - OR  
Combination II: Any one Language from List A + Any one subject from either List B1 or List B2 + SECTION III of CUET (General Test)
  - Merit will be based on the CUET scores obtained from the above-mentioned combination of subjects.
  - Note: As the weightage of the CUET Sections is not the same, appropriate proration will be done.

# *Courses offered and eligibility criteria*

## **Bachelor of Elementary Education B. El. Ed**

- We offer 54 seats in this course.
- Course fee: Rs 22885
- Eligibility Criteria
  - Candidates must appear in CUET in the following subject combination:  
Any one Language from List A + Any two subjects from List B1 + Any one subject from either List B1 or List B2
  - Merit will be based on the CUET scores obtained from the above-mentioned combination of subjects.

# *Courses offered and eligibility criteria*

## **B.A. Program**

- We offer 246 seats offered for this course in 28 discipline specific combinations out of which **123** are reserved for minority.
- Course fee ranges from Rs 17685 to Rs 19285 depending upon the combination chosen
- Eligibility Criteria
  - Candidates must appear in CUET in the following subject combination:  
Combination I: Any one Language from List A + Any two subjects from List B1 + Any one subject from either List B1 or List B2  
  
OR  
Combination II: Any one language from List A + Any one subject from either List B1 or List B2 + SECTION III of CUET (General Test)
  - Merit will be based on the CUET scores obtained from the above-mentioned combination of subjects.
  - Note: As the weightage of the CUET Sections is not the same, appropriate proration will be done

# *Reservations and Relaxations*

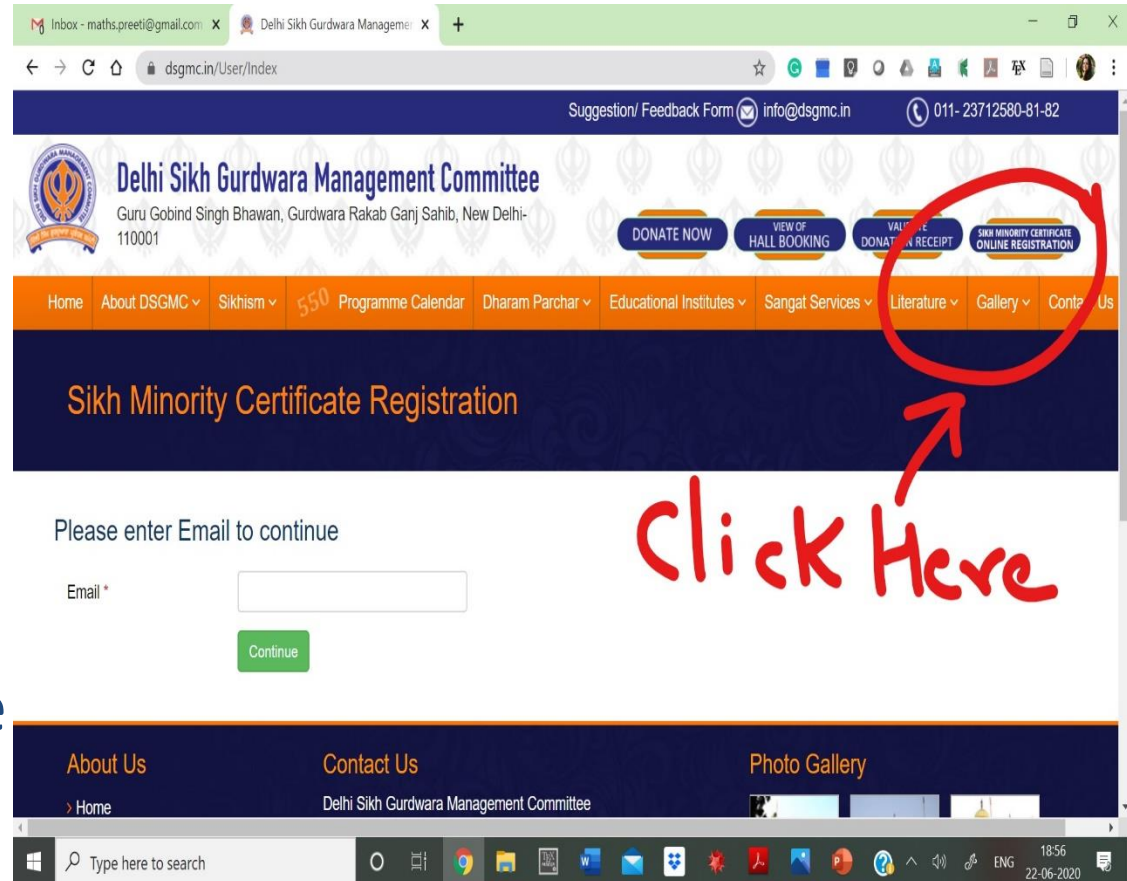
Apart from 50% Reservation of Seats for Persons with Sikh Minority Status, college has reservation for Following categories as per Delhi University Guidelines

- Reservation of Seats for Persons with Disabilities (PwD) (atleast 5% Supernumerary Seats)
- Reservation for Children/Widows of Personnel of the Armed Forces (CW) (5 % of seats)
- Reservation of Kashmiri Migrants (KM) (Up to 5% seats Supernumerary Seats)
- Seats for Ward Quota
- Reservation of Seats for Foreign Applicants
- Extra-curricular and Sports Quota (Supernumerary Seats)



# *Procedure of issuance of Sikh minority certificate*

- Then visit the DSGMC website <https://www.dsgmc.in/User/Index>
- Enter your Email ID
- Enter the OTP you received on Email
- Carefully fill in the details and upload videos and documents
- Click on Submit
- You'll receive your e-certificate after verification



# *Procedure of issuance of Sikh minority certificate*

## ➤ Requirements:

- **Student video should have below mentioned declaration:**  
I xxxxxxxx son/daughter of xxxxxxxx request you to issue me Sikh Minority certificate. I wish to assure you that I follow teachings of Guru Granth Sahib ji and follow sikh traditions only. I also wish to submit that I do not trim or cut my hair. If in future I am found cutting or trimming my hair, dsgmc has full right to cancel my minority certificate.
- **Father / Guardian video should have below mentioned declaration:**  
I am xxxxxxxx father/mother/guardian of xxxxxxxx. He/she wishes to apply for the minority certificate from DSGMC. I assure that I do not trim/cut my hair and follow teachings of Guru Granth Sahib ji. If in future I am found cutting or trimming my hair, dsgmc has full right to cancel my ward's minority certificate.

# *Procedure of issuance of Sikh minority certificate*

- Birth Certificate (If New Admission)
- Last Year's Marks Sheet
- Student's Aadhaar Card/Address
- Father/Mother/Guardian ID Proof
- Affidavit Proof (If Singh/Kaur recently Updated in Name)
- All documents should be in .jpg or .jpeg format with a maximum size upto 1 MB.
- All videos should be in .mp4 format with maximum size upto 5 MB

- Common University Entrance Test (CUET (UG) – 2022) will be conducted in 13 mediums across India for admission into the Undergraduate Programmes in Computer Based Test (CBT) mode for all the Central Universities (CUs) in India for the academic year 2022-23.

# General Steps

- **Step 1 Registration:** All applicants must register through the University of Delhi online admissions portal <https://ug.du.ac.in>. All undergraduate admissions for 2021-22 will be administered only through this portal. **There is no offline admission for any applicant.**
- **Step II Payment of the registration** fees must be done only through the link provided through the applicant's Dashboard
- **Step III Reopening of the portal:** The application will be allowed to update the marks and make minor corrections in the form during this window provided to them. This will only be a one time process.
- **Step IV Selection of Course and college after declaration of cut off:** Applicants must log in to their Dashboards on the UG admission portal to choose the course and college they wish to claim admission in from the list of colleges and courses they are eligible for. At a time, during a cut-off list, the applicant is allowed to choose only one course and one college. Multiple simultaneous admissions are not permitted
- **Step V Online verification of documents** by respective colleges: College shall verify the documents uploaded by the applicant for eligibility and meeting the required Cut -Off. . College will either approve or decline admission
- **Step VI Payment of fees to confirm admission:** The applicant should pay the fee without delay within 24 hours of the approval of admission by the Principal of the College, and save the acknowledgement slip online through portal.
- Applicants will be required to appear in person at the University of Delhi only at the very end of the admission process, for verification of certificates as per the schedule to be announced by the University/ College.

## *Common minimum eligibility*

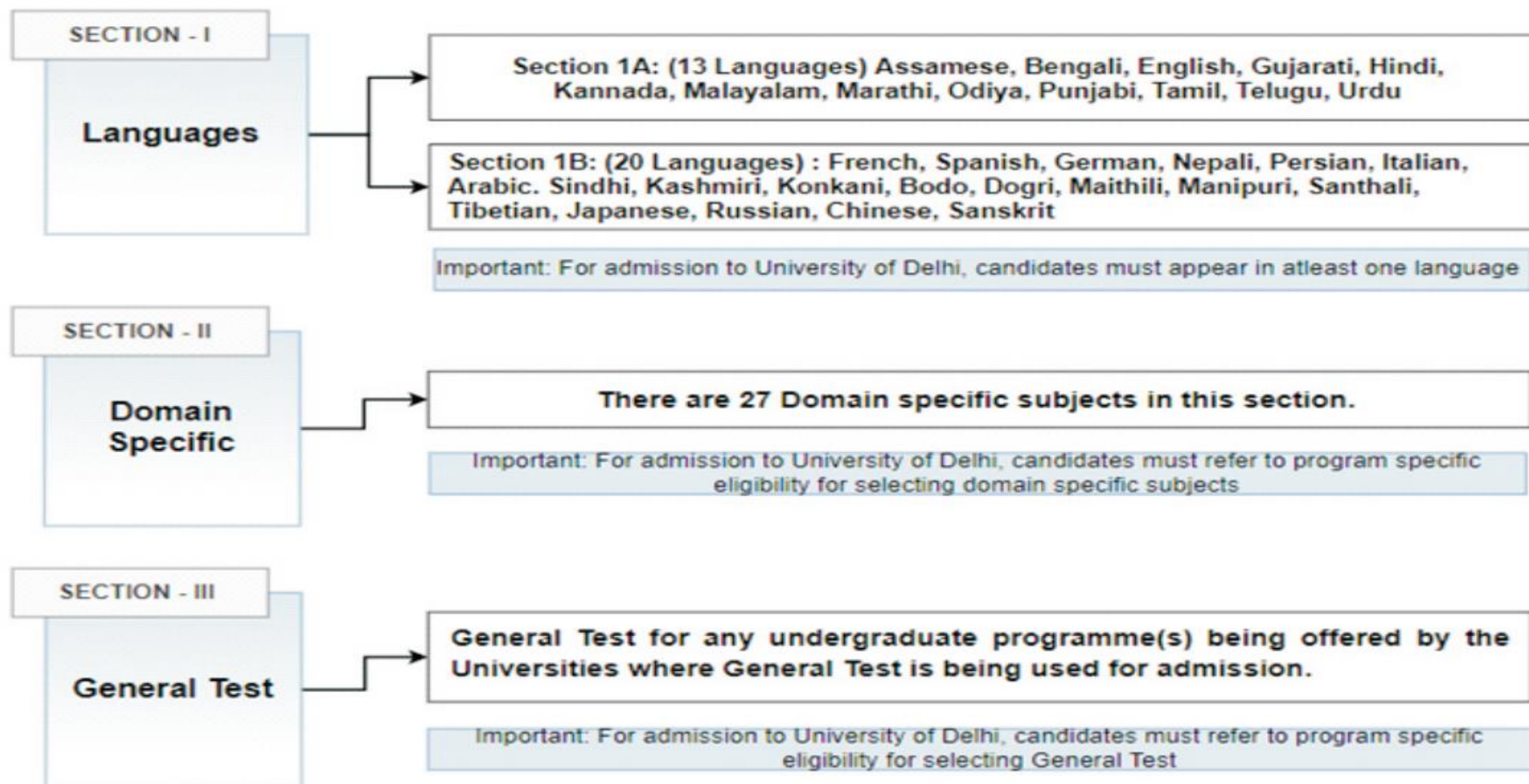
- The candidate must have passed the Class XII or its equivalent examination from a single recognized board.

## *Program-specific Eligibility*

- List of subjects/Papers to be chosen in CUET 2022 for admission to undergraduate programme is divided into TWO LISTS : LIST A and LIST B. List A mentions languages. List B mentions program specific subjects. Only the papers mentioned in List B will be considered as subjects for Program-specific eligibility.

# *General Guidelines*

- The applicant must be a citizen of India.
- The applicant should have passed the class 12th examination of any board / University admission in India or any foreign country recognized as equivalent to the 10 + 2 system by the Association of India University (AIU).
- Applicants with gap year(s) will not be at any disadvantage for admission to undergraduate courses.
- 10% of supernumerary seats in each program are reserved for foreign nationals. Candidates seeking Admission under the foreign students category are required to apply on foreign students registry website: <https://fsr.du.ac.in>
- **Candidates from the Sikh minorities may also seek admission under the minority quota in the minority colleges of the university. All such candidates must appear in CUET 2022. In minority colleges 50% of the seats are for candidates belonging to unreserved category and 50% are reserved for minority candidates.**
- Admission to school of open learning (SOL) and NCWEB will be based on class 12th marks. Candidates must register themselves on [www.admission.uod.ac.in](http://www.admission.uod.ac.in)

# IMPORTANT POINTS

- *Admissions to all Undergraduate Programmes at the University of Delhi will be based on the scores obtained in CUET 2022 (except for admissions to the School of Open Learning (SOL), Non-College Women Education Board NCWEB, and Foreign Nationals).*
- *An eligible candidate desirous of seeking admissions to the Undergraduate Program(s) of the University of Delhi for the academic session 2022-23 must read the contents of this Bulletin of Information as well as the notifications, updates and information published on the admission website of the University of Delhi.*
- *Candidates must appear in CUET in only those subjects in which he/she has passed class 12<sup>th</sup>.*
- *In case the subject studied at class 12<sup>th</sup> is not mentioned in the CUET, the candidates must appear in the subject that is similar/closely related to the subject he/she has studied at class 12<sup>th</sup> (for example, if a candidate has studied Biochemistry in class 12<sup>th</sup>, he/she must appear in biology in CUET 2022)*
- *Merit will be based only on the 'combinations of the subjects in which a candidate has appeared in CUET' as mentioned in the respective Program-Specific Eligibility.*

# IMPORTANT POINTS

- *The candidate must have studied and passed class 12<sup>th</sup> Examination or its equivalent from a single recognised board.*
- *Only the scores obtained in CUET 2022 will be considered for admissions to the academic year 2022-23.*
- *Candidates must study the Program-Specific requirements carefully and then appear in the Subjects/papers of the CUET 2022.*
- *The candidates are advised to check that they satisfy all the eligibility criteria for the program(s) for which they are applying in the entrance test. Admission is subject to the candidate's fulfilling the eligibility requirements prescribed for applying to the concerned program of study. In case the candidate does not meet any eligibility criteria prescribed for applying to the concerned program and appears in the entrance test. It is at the candidate's own risk and cost. If at any stage, it is found that the eligibility requirements are not fulfilled, the admission, if granted shall be cancelled ipso facto.*
- *Before registering for CUET 2022, the candidates are advised to carefully read the Bulletin of Information and consult the Delhi University Act, 1922 and the Statutes. The Ordinances, Rules and Regulations of the University of Delhi, available on the University website, would be binding on them.*

# IMPORTANT POINTS

- *As per Ordinance-I of University, there is no minimum bar for admissions to the undergraduate programs in the university and its colleges except in the programs where the respective regulatory bodies, such as Medical Council of India (MCI), All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE), Bar Council of India (BCI), National Council of Teacher Education (NCTE), Dental Council of India (DCI), etc. have prescribed the minimum age requirements in their regulations.*
- *Gap year will not be a bar for purpose of admission to the undergraduate programs. However, such candidates must also appear in CUET-for admissions in academic year-2022.*
