Mata Sundri college for women, named after Mata Sundri ji. The consort of the tenth Guru, GURU GOBIND SINGH JI, was established to propagate the cherished ideals of service, leadership, social responsibility and academic pursuits among young woman with the motto.

Truth is the highest of all virtues but true living is higher still. Mata Sundri college for women is an Institution where we strive to achieve excellence in higher education and woman empowerment. A constituent college of the university of Delhi, The college was founded on 17th July, 1967 by the Gurudwara prabhandak committee, Delhi state.

#### **Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board**

In 1943, by a Delhi University act, Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board was established, where in women students were enabled to take some of the examination of the University with special coaching but without attending regular classes. This gave shape to the Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board (NCWEB).

The Board began functioning in September, 1944 with 3 students. At present, the enrolment is more than 24,000. Only women students residing in the National capital Territory of Delhi can enroll themselves as students of the Board. NCWEB is a unique system with lectures on Sunday and academic breaks leaving students with six working days to follow their dream. In this neo–age of 100% cut-offs, class room crunch, gender discrimination, NCWEB is a welcome arrangement and a most satisfactory way to attain a degree from University of Delhi.


#### TALK "YOUTH LEADERSHIP"









## Talk "Managing Stress"
