ABOUT THE COURSE

The Department of Political Science and IQAC, MSCW in collaboration with Divah Sprik LawNotes (DSLN) is organising an online 30-hours certificate course on Legal Awareness. It is a firm belief of the Organisers that in order to reform any Society, the people must be empowered with the knowledge to deal with issues of the prevailing law. Only with the consciousness of legal culture and pro-active participation of the individuals can real change be brought about.

This course has been specifically designed for undergraduates who are not involved in the course of law. Without legal literacy, people tend to get intimidated by authorities and justice often remains unserved. By way of legal education and an array of activities, the organisers wish to cater to the end beneficiaries, i.e., the society, by spreading legal awareness, so that the problem of lack of implementation of the law can be tackled at the foundational stage itself.

This integrative course encompasses Interactive Sessions, topics of which are based on theoretical as well as practical aspects of law, and Evaluations by way of which, the organisers can best assist the participant. The course module is divided into mainly 3 categories:

- Introduction to Law (Theory): This will include a brief overview and history of the Constitution, Civil Law and Criminal Law, with detailed sessions on Women-Related Laws in India
- <u>Implementation of Law (Practical)</u>: The Participants will be given both theoretical and practical training regarding more commonly used laws, such as filing of FIR, Sexual Harassment Complaint, RTI, Cyber Complaint and Medical Negligence Complaint. They will also be briefed about free Legal Aid Services and Schemes provided by the Government and how the same can be accessed.
- Expert Address: The Participants will be given the opportunity to attend a special session on the understanding about the Farm Laws, to be chaired by an Expert.

REGISTRATION DETAILS

- To enroll in the course, the Applicant is required to register through the Registration Link provided in the Brochure;
- The Fees for the Course is Rs. 200/- (per head) (Non-Refundable);
- Registration for the Course will close on 7th October, 2021
- Login Details will be provided to the Applicant once registration is completed and payment is processed.





TO BE NOTED:

- The Course will be conducted entirely via virtual mode and there will be no physical classes.
- The Course will commence from 16th October, 2021.
- This is a 30-hours Course and classes will be held on weekends (i.e. Saturday-Sunday) only.
- All reading material will be provided in electronic format.
- The medium of instruction will be bilingual, i.e., Hindi and English.
- A Course Completion Certificate will be issued to the participant only after fulfilling the stipulated 30 hours of attendance and scoring of 50% in Evaluations.
- The Course has been designed keeping in mind both theoretical and practical aspects of Indian Law, coupled with analysis of case laws, scholarly engagements, strategic evaluation methods, assessment techniques among several other innovative approaches.
