## **QUIZ COMPETITION**

## **HIV-AIDS AND OTHER HEALTH RELATED TOPICS**

Parivartan, the NSS unit of Mata Sundri College for Women sent 2 of its volunteers for a Quiz Competition organized by the District AIDS Prevention and Control Unit (DAPCU) - Central Delhi under the Delhi State AIDS Control Society (DSACS) for youth from different colleges/ institutions. It was held on 10th December, 2021 at 12 PM at Conference Hall, Centre of Excellence (CoE), Near B. L. Taneja Block, Maulana Azad Medical College (MAMC), Delhi-110002.

The theme of the quiz revolved around HIV-AIDS, TB, Blood Donation & other Health related topics. The volunteers were asked to bring bank details, i.e. scanned copy of Cheque or first page of Passbook for TA purpose in Quiz Competition. There were 6 teams (having 2 participants each) competing in the competition. Each team was given a certain name. For example, the Mata Sundri College for Women team was given the name 'Care'. As the participants reached the venue, they were required to fill a form mentioning their details and were given a folder containing a mask, a pen, a notepad and a small booklet highlighting AIDS awareness.

After that, the participants had a talk regarding HIV - AIDS with a knowledgeable resource person, following which the quiz was conducted. There were 7 rounds, 4 marks were awarded for every correct answer, 1 mark was deducted for every wrong answer and 1 mark was awarded for correctly answering a passed question. 30 seconds were given to each team for answering a question and 10 seconds for answering a passed question. After the completion of 7 rounds, Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan team occupied the first position. There was a tie between 4 teams for the second position due to which a tie breaker round was played leading to the Lakshmi Bai College team occupying the second position. Though the Mata Sundri College for Women team did not win, but it undoubtedly proved to be a great experience for them as they learnt various new facts about many Health topics.
